SUBJECT: Lottery Deer/Pig Hunting Event on Camp Roberts 20-22 September 2017

1. **Eligible Personnel:** Camp Roberts is open to personnel from the California Military Department, DoD active or veteran and Coast Guard active or veteran and authorized guests for the hunting of Deer/Pig. Fishing is closed during this period.

a. Forms will be online at <http://www.calguard.ca.gov/CR/Pages/Camp-Roberts-Hunting-and-Fishing.aspx>. Must have a valid Camp Roberts Hunting license at the time of entry.

b. Fill out and email to jamie.m.clinton.mil@mail.mil.

c. 25 spots available.

d. The drawing will occur 11 August 2017.

2. **Registration:** Registration is open by appointment only. **This hunt is by Lottery only.** All persons hunting on Camp Roberts are required to have a valid California Hunting License, valid California Big Game Hunting Tag(s), and a valid Camp Roberts Hunting/Fishing Permit.

3. **Administrative Requirements:** Hunters and guests must have a valid U.S. Government/State issued Identification Card on their person at all times. In addition, hunters will also maintain Camp Roberts Annual Hunting/Fishing Permit, proof of eligibility status, valid California Hunting License and valid California Big Game Hunting Tag(s) on their person at all times.

4. **Time and Location:** All participants are required to check in and out of Gate 1. Access to hunting areas begins at 0500. Hunting and shooting hours for big game (deer and wild pig), shall be from one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset. Checkout is not later than one hour after sunset.

5. **Game:** Participants may pursue and take approved game (Deer/Pig) as defined in current year's State of California Hunting Regulations.

6. **Safety and Environmental:** Approved hunting area maps, take information forms and other administrative information are provided to registered hunters during check in. Only non-lead ammunition is authorized for hunting on Camp Roberts. All weapons brought onto Camp Roberts must be transported and stored in accordance with California State Law. All participants are reminded to pick up their expended shell casings and trash during this event.

7. **Legal:** California Fish and Wildlife Enforcement Officers are actively involved with the Camp Roberts Hunting and Fishing Program, and have full access to the entire facility. All participants are required to follow the State of California hunting and fishing guidelines and regulations, and comply with Camp Roberts' rules and policies while on Camp Roberts. Violations of any guidelines, regulations, rules, post procedures and/or policies may result in forfeiture of fees paid, a revocation of hunting privileges at Camp Roberts, and you may be subject to additional California State Law and federal law sanctions.

8. **Proof of Eligibility:** This is a Service Member and Veteran hunt. Hunters are required to provide proof of eligibility at time of entry/registration. United States Government Uniformed Services Identification, DD Form 214, and Veterans Administration Identification is considered proof of eligibility.
