Job Scope

Nalco, an Ecolab Company, has a Delivery Driver position open at the Nalco Cal Water facility in Placentia, California. Interested candidate will report to Placentia, CA each day and will be dispatched to deliver water treatment equipment throughout LA County, Orange County and San Diego County. Deliveries will be limited to a normal work-day, and routed accordingly. Delivery technicians will work in a hands-on / mechanical aptitude fashion including but not limited to the following: movement of tanks, loading and unloading of commercial delivery trucks, connection/hooks up of water treatment equipment, as well as fixing, repairing, monitoring of water treatment equipment performance. Candidate will require the capacity to learn and understand ion exchange regeneration process and portable exchange delivery method, as well as learn and understand hydraulic, pneumatic, electrical protocol of ion exchange regeneration processes. In addition to the normal work week, this position will have minimal overtime expectations.

Job Responsibilities

- Drive delivery truck with heavy load, remain attentive and utilize defensive driving skills on a minute by minute basis due to Southern California freeway system and congestion
- Load and unload portable exchange bottles via lift-gate at customer sites and at plant regeneration pad via transfer equipment
- Move portable exchange bottles from delivery trucks to installation sites at customer locations
- Prepare, review and plan for loading each day
- Work in a wet & mechanical environment, follow all safety rules and requirements
- Performing other administrative related duties as required
- Take appropriate initiative to deal with potential issues before they become problems

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or GED required; trade school certification or other degree a plus
- Must have a strong mechanical aptitude with a great attitude
- Experience in servicing a mechanical product and/or installation, repair, and maintenance of water treatment equipment not required, but a plus!
- Must be able to lift 50 lbs, ability to perform some physically demanding activities at customer sites
- Previous safety and/or hazmat training a plus
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record, Commercial "A" or "B" license a plus
- Ability to work on a flexible work schedule
