Department Overview

The Security Department oversees safety of the public and our employees and the security requirements for Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP).

Position Summary

This job is represented by Service Employees International Union (SEIU) and is subject to collective bargaining. PG&E is seeking highly motivated individuals in the field of nuclear security. These are temporary positions, and relocation assistance is not provided.

As an officer, you must be able to achieve and maintain qualifications to perform security functions, as detailed in the Security Training and Qualification Program, per the Code of Federal Regulations 10CFR73.55, Appendix B, physical requirements, and are subject to the NRC mandated Behavior Observation Program for continued employment.

To obtain and maintain employment and unescorted access at DCPP, you must be able to pass a drug and alcohol screen, a background check in accordance with NRC standards with no criminal history that reflects "reliability or trustworthiness issues," psychological screen, computer-based training, NRC physical examination, and be subject to random drug and alcohol screening and passing future physical exams.

Responsibilities:

- Follow DCPP site standards and procedures
- Protect Security Safeguards Information
- Maintain personal training, qualification, and certifications

Qualifications

Minimum:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must possess a high school diploma or GED
- Must possess a California driver's license or the ability to obtain one by first day of employment
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds a minimum of one time a day

- Ability to climb stairs and ladders, walk up to five miles a day, and bend, stoop, and twist
- Distant visual acuity in each eye must be correctable to 20/30 in the better eye and 20/40 in the other eye with corrective lenses
- Ability to distinguish between the colors red, yellow, and green.
- Ability to work any and all shifts and holidays, including overtime, with little-to-no notice.
- Ability and willingness to wear personal protective equipment

Desired:

- Experience in law enforcement, security, military, or emergency services
- Demonstrated experience working different shifts, weekends, and holidays
- Demonstrated ability to maintain professional composure and make sound decisions when dealing with unusual/emergency circumstances
- Demonstrated ability to write routine correspondence, including logs and reports
- Good interpersonal skills with demonstrated ability to interact effectively at various social levels and across diverse cultures
- Self-motivated and strong work ethics
- Demonstrated ability to read and comprehend detailed regulations and follow written and oral instructions
- Armed security experience in an industrial environment
