MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Bonus List Changes (Policy Number 00-08)

1. The National Guard Bureau (NGB) will consider requests for changes to the approved FY01 bonus lists. Requests to move non-high priority units to the high-priority unit bonus lists cannot be supported. However, a request to add a non-high priority unit to the non-high priority list will be considered.
2. NGB will submit all valid requests for changes to the approving agency, the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Manpower and Reserve Affairs ASA (M&RA). The ASA (M&RA) has been willing to allow the Army National Guard to bonus non-high priority units and skills that do not meet the requirements of Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI). guidance in order to meet end of year strength goals. Changes of this nature cause the ASA(M&RA) to re-look his policy and place our incentive programs in jeopardy overall.
