Non-Prior Service (NPS) applicants who complete a SRIP contract (to include the Kicker) will remain in that contracted MOS duty position until successful completion of IADT (Phase II for split option) and award of the MOS. The exception to this is a reassignment due to reorganization, de-activation, or re-location of the unit of assignment.
