

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Continuation of the Selected Reserve Incentive Program (SRIP) and Education Benefits Eligibility While Serving Under a Presidential Selected Reserve Call-Up (PSRC) (Policy Number 99-3)

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to provide guidance on the continued receipt of SRIP incentives during a mobilization under a PSRC.
2. Under Title 10, United States Code, Section 12304, the president has the authority to order units and individuals of the Selected Reserve to involuntary active duty for a period of no longer than 270 days under the PSRC.
3. Soldiers ordered to active duty under the PSRC will retain all incentives for which they had contracted prior to being ordered to active duty. Incentives will not be suspended or terminated due to participation under the authority of the PSRC.
4. Soldiers participating in the Student Loan Repayment Program (SLRP) and wish to suspend loan repayment under the Soldiers and Sailors Relief Act must coordinate with the lending institution prior to mobilization.
5. Soldiers eligible for Montgomery GI Bill (MGIB) benefits or MGIB Kicker program prior to mobilization and who reaffiliates within 90 days of release from such period of active duty will have their 10-year eligibility window extended for the time they were mobilized plus four additional months.
6. Upon receipt of mobilization orders soldiers who would qualify for a reenlistment/extension bonus during the period of service on active duty may extend outside the 90 day window and receive the bonus. The reenlistment/extension must be for the number of whole years equal to or greater than any remaining statutory military service obligation but no less than three years.
