**2012 FEDERAL HOLIDAY SCHEDULE**

**Expires 31 December 2012**

1. Federal holidays for 2012 will be observed as follows:

<b>Weekday</b>	<b>Date</b>	<b>Holiday</b>
Monday	2 January 2012*	New Year's Day
Monday	16 January 2012	Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr.
Monday	20 February 2012**	Washington's Birthday
Monday	28 May 2012	Memorial Day
Wednesday	4 July 2012	Independence Day
Monday	3 September 2012	Labor Day
Monday	8 October 2012	Columbus Day
Monday	12 November 2012***	Veterans Day
Thursday	22 November 2012	Thanksgiving Day
Tuesday	25 December 2012	Christmas Day

\* 1 January 2012 (the legal public holiday for New Year's Day), falls on a Sunday. For most Federal employees, Monday, 2 January, will be treated as a holiday for pay and leave purposes. (See section 3(a) of Executive order 11582, 11 February 1971.)

\*\* This holiday is designated as "Washington's Birthday" in section 6103(a) of Title 5 of the U.S.C., which is the law that specifies holidays for Federal employees. Though other installations such as state/local governments and private businesses may use other names, it is Federal policy to always refer to holidays by the names designated in the law.

\*\*\* 11 November 2012 (the legal public holiday for Veterans Day), falls on a Sunday. For most Federal employees, Monday, 12 November, will be treated as a holiday for pay and leave purposes. (See section 3(a) of Executive order 11582, 11 February 1971.)
