

History. This regulation supersedes CA SMR REG 672-2, dated 1 May 1991.

Summary. This regulation prescribes the policies and procedures for the design, issuance, control, awarding and wear of the CA SMR General Staff Identification Badge.

Applicability. This regulation applies to all elements of the California State Military Reserve.

Proponent and exception authority. The proponent and exception authority of this regulation is the Adjutant General of the State of California. Supplementation and any exceptions to this regulation are prohibited without prior written approval from the Deputy Adjutant General, Army Division or the Commanding General, CA SMR.

Interim changes. Interim changes in this regulation are not official unless they are authenticated by the Deputy Adjutant General, Army Division or the Commanding General, CA SMR.

Suggested improvements. Users are invited to send comments and suggested improvements on DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms), directly to the Personnel Section, HQ, CA SMR (CASR-P).

Distribution. Distribution of this regulation is CA SMR-A.

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Chapter 1 GENERAL

1-1. Purpose

To establish the criteria for eligibility for award and wear of the California State Military Reserve General Staff Identification Badge.

1-2. Policy

a. The Commanding General, California State Military Reserve, with the concurrence of the Adjutant General of the state of California has authorized a CA SMR General Staff Identification Badge to uniquely identify personnel assigned to an authorized TDA position on the Headquarters, CA SMR Staff. No other CA SMR command group is authorized issue or wear of this badge.

b. The badge may only be awarded to and worn by those personnel who meet all the eligibility criteria outlined in this regulation.

c. The badge is an award for superior service and is only authorized for permanent wear by Headquarters, CA SMR Staff Personnel who:

(1) Have demonstrated outstanding performance while assigned to a senior general or special staff position authorized by the HQ, CA SMR TDA.

(2) Have served in that TDA staff position or another authorized staff position for a minimum of 18 months and have attended a minimum of 15 UTAs. If any UTAs were missed, individual will qualify only when a total of 15 UTAs shall have been compiled as indicated by the HQ, CA SMR staff sign-in sheet and certified by the HQ, CA SMR Personnel section's attendance records.

(3) Are recommended for the award by the Chief of Staff and approved by the Commanding General, CA SMR.

(4) Are within the height/weight limits specified by CA SMR Regulation 600-9.

(5) Have been awarded the badge by official publication of Permanent Orders from HQ, CA SMR.

Chief of Staff or the Commanding General (see Appendix C).

c. Upon receipt and presentation of the official permanent orders, the individual concerned may purchase one (1) CA SMR General Staff Identification Badge from the CA SMR Personnel Section.

2-2. Wear of Award

a. Wear of the CA SMR General Staff Identification Badge will be in the same manner as prescribed for wear of the Army General staff Identification Badge, centered on the right pocket of the Class B shirt or Class A blouse as described in Army Regulation AR 670-1. CA SMR Personnel who are authorized to wear the Army General Staff Identification Badge and who are subsequently awarded the CA SMR General Staff Identification Badge may wear both badges side by side on the right pocket of the Class B shirt or Class A Blouse.

b. A copy of the permanent order authorizing award of the CA SMR General Staff Identification Badge will be maintained in the individual's MPRJ as evidence of eligibility for permanent wear of the badge.

Chapter 2 PROCEDURES

2-1. Procedures

a. When the required minimum service on the Headquarters CA SMR staff is completed and certified and outstanding performance has been demonstrated as indicated by one or more OERs or NCOERs, the Chief of Staff, CA SMR may submit a formal recommendation to the Commanding General, CA SMR, requesting approval to make the award and have permanent orders published.

b. Upon approval by the CG, CA SMR, the Personnel Section will cause to be published orders authorizing the permanent wear of the badge and issue a special certificate attesting to the award signed by the


