MEMORANDUM FOR All Camp San Luis Obispo (CSLO) Employees, Tenants and Transient Users

SUBJECT: Mobile Communication Device Use While Operating a Motor Vehicle (CSLO Policy Memorandum #08-04)

1. Effective immediately, Mobile Communication Devices (MCD's), including cellular phones and blackberries, will only be authorized while operating a motor vehicle if a hands free listening device is being utilized.
2. This restriction applies to all personnel, military and civilian, in any status while operating a motor vehicle on Camp San Luis Obispo.
3. This restriction does not apply to personnel using a MCD for emergency purposes. Examples are; an emergency call to a law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department, or other emergency services agency.
4. This section does not apply to emergency services personnel using a MCD while operating an authorized emergency vehicle, as defined in Section 165 of the California Vehicle Code in the course and scope of their duties.
