MEMORANDUM FOR All Camp San Luis Obispo (CSLO) Employees, Tenants and Transient Users

SUBJECT: Motorcycle Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) (CSLO Policy Memorandum #08-05)

1. References: Department of Defense Instruction 6055.4 and AR 385-10, Army Safety Program para 11-9d.
2. Effective immediately, the following PPE is mandatory by personnel operating or riding as a passenger on a motorcycle, moped, or ATV on Camp San Luis Obispo in accordance with the above reference.
 - a. Helmets, certified to meet Department of Transportation standards, must be properly fastened under the chin.
 - b. Impact or shatter resistant goggles, wraparound glasses, or full-face shield properly attached to the helmet must meet or exceed American National Standards Institute Safety Code Z87.1, for impact and shatter resistance. A windshield alone is not proper eye protection.
 - c. Sturdy footwear, leather boots or over the ankle shoes must be worn.
 - d. A long sleeved shirt or jacket, and long trousers.
 - e. Closed-finger gloves. The intent is to protect riders' fingers from the strikes of flying objects. The glove should be made for motorcycle use. Gloves that are not for motorcycle use provide less grip and protection.
 - f. For on-road operations, a brightly colored, outer upper garment during the day and a reflective upper garment during the night. Military uniforms do not meet this criteria. The outer garment shall be clearly visible and not obscured.
 - g. During off-road operations, operators and riders must use additional PPE, such as knee and shin guards and padded full fingered gloves.
