MEMORANDUM FOR All Camp San Luis Obispo (CSLO) Employees and Tenants

SUBJECT: Long Term Housing (CSLO Policy Memo #07-03)

1. Reference National Guard Regulation 210-50 paragraph 2-1 [Chargeable Transient Quarters & Billeting Fund Management].
2. The purpose of this memorandum is to remind all personnel of current policy governing long term housing at CSLO.
3. In a recent internal audit and occupancy review it was noted that several active Guard Reservists, Civil Servants, Federal Technicians, and Active Duty for Special Work personnel have occupied chargeable and non-chargeable quarters for extensive periods that exceed 179 days as authorized by NGR 210-50.
4. In accordance with NG Regulation 210-50, Paragraph 2-1, an Army National Guard (ARNG) Training Center is not authorized permanent housing facilities, family quarters or guest housing. CSLO operates a stand-alone Billeting Fund to provide transient guest quarters for official visitors. The National Guard Bureau prohibits all Army National Guard installations from providing long term lodging for more than 179 days per calendar year for any person. Exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Adjutant General for California.
5. In order to expedite requests for exceptions to this policy, personnel must submit a written request with justification through this command for concurrence, endorsement and approval by The Office of The Adjutant General. Extenuating circumstances such as permanent residency outside reasonable commuting distance and personal financial hardship will be considered. Only requests from personnel assigned to or employed by the California National Guard working at CSLO will be considered.
