MEMORANDUM FOR All Camp San Luis Obispo (CSLO) Employees, Tenants and Transient Users

SUBJECT: Installation Traffic Regulations (CSLO Policy Memorandum #12-01)

1. The driver of any vehicle on CSLO shall adhere to all State of California and local traffic laws.
2. The maximum speed a vehicle may travel is as follows:
  - a. All roads on CSLO property unless otherwise posted: 25 MPH.
  - b. Active construction areas: 15 MPH.
  - c. When passing troops or persons working along the sides of the roadway: 10 MPH.
3. Department of Defense Instruction 6055.04 prohibits the use of radar or laser detection devices that detect the presence of speed recording instruments or transmit simulated erroneous speeds on installations. Prior to entering Camp San Luis Obispo (CSLO) all radar and laser detecting devices must be disconnected from their power source and remain properly stored while on CSLO property.
4. State of California Peace Officers are authorized to make contact with any person(s) while on CSLO property for violations of California Law which consists of 29 codes, covering various subject areas of the State Constitution and Statutes. Security Forces (SECFOR) may also make contact with individuals violating any CSLO policy.
5. Restraint systems will be worn by occupants of motor vehicles while driving on CSLO at all times. Restraint systems are required only in vehicles manufactured after model year 1966.
6. Violations of the above information could result in the issuance of a citation by Law Enforcement Officers (LEO) or the issuance of DD Form 1408 Armed Forces Traffic Ticket by SECFOR personnel. This could lead to the suspension or revocation of CSLO driving privileges, depending on the severity of the incident.
7. This policy memorandum supersedes CSLO Policy Memorandum #08-08.
